Student Achievement Procedure

At Governors Bay School we put in place a comprehensive programme that ensures all students have access to high quality teaching and learning.

In order to have this happen at Governors Bay School we will:

- **Success for all**
All year 0 to 8 students will be given opportunities to gain the knowledge, skills, attitudes, and values identified in the New Zealand Curriculum Framework and the national curriculum statements.
- **A Safe Learning Environment**
Governors Bay School provides a safe, physical and emotional environment for all students.
- **Improving Literacy and Numeracy**
Governors Bay School places priority on improving student achievement in literacy and numeracy, especially in years 1 to 4. Special emphasis is placed on students whose further education or training may be at risk through under-achievement in literacy and/or numeracy.
- **Better Use of Student Achievement Information**
Governors Bay School gathers sufficiently comprehensive assessment evidence to evaluate the progress and achievement of their students, to implement future teaching and learning priorities.
- **Improving Outcomes for Students**
Drawing on dependable assessment evidence, Governors Bay School will improve outcomes for students who are not achieving, who are at risk of not achieving, or who have special learning needs.
- **Improving Maori Outcomes**
Governors Bay School works with our Maori community to plan, set targets that achieve better outcomes for Maori students.

- **Providing Career Guidance**

Governors Bay School provides career guidance in Year 7 and above. Special emphasis is placed on career guidance for at risk students who are unprepared for the transition to the workplace or for further study.

- **Reporting**

Governors Bay School reports to students and their parents on the achievement of individual students and to the school's community on the achievement of students as a whole. Governors Bay School also reports on the progress of groups identified in the national education priorities.

- **Reviewing**

Governors Bay School maintains an on-going programme of self-review in relation to procedures, programmes and planning for curriculum and student achievement.

In order to meet these requirements, the management of Governors Bay School has developed and is implementing:

- *A curriculum delivery statement –*
- *School's specific statement or programme (found elsewhere)*
- *A curriculum delivery programme for essential learning areas*
- *including literacy and numeracy foci.*

School develops themselves -

- *A curriculum development programme (updated annually)*
- *An assessment and evaluation programme*
- *A reporting to parents programme*
- *An education outside the classroom programme EOTC*
- *A special needs programme*
- *An on-going programme of curriculum review and reporting to the BOT*
- *An on-going timetable of curriculum programme and overview rewriting*
- *Other programmes as funded from time to time by the Ministry of Education eg Reading Recovery*

Through regular reporting at Board of Trustee level, the Board of Trustees will be assured that the curriculum at Governors Bay School has the infrastructure to allow for successful delivery and student achievement.
